More than 90 distinguished galleries from around the world will participate, presenting some of the most beautiful objects from modern and contemporary art, jewelry, antiques, and design. TEFAP New York will be on view from May 12-16, 2023, with an invitation-only Collectors Preview on May 11, 2023.
