# TEFAF NEW YORK GEARS UP FOR A TRIUMPHANT RETURN IN MAY

The fair announces its 91 exhibitors, set to showcase an array of modern and contemporary art, jewelry, antiquities and design

(New York) February 23, 2022–For the first time since 2019, TEFAF New York is hosting an in-person fair–and it is anticipated to be as exceptional as ever. This year, 91 distinguished galleries from around the world will participate, presenting modern and contemporary art, jewelry, antiquities, and design. TEFAF New York will take over the Park Avenue Armory from May 6-10, 2022, with an invitation-only VIP day on May 5, 2022.

TEFAF New York will once again provide art enthusiasts, collectors, design professionals, and museum curators the opportunity to experience curated spaces within the captivating period rooms of the Armory, in addition to the soaring 55,000 square foot Wade Thompson Drill Hall.
