COURSE ASSIGNMENT: A STRATEGIC APPROACH TO INFORMED ACQUISITIONS

This innovative course offers participants the opportunity to work together in groups, utilizing the knowledge and insights gained from lectures and mentor sessions to develop an informed strategy for expanding collections. The course culminates in a presentation of a acquisition strategy to a simulated leadership panel, providing a comprehensive understanding of the multifaceted considerations required when preparing for an acquisition, whether through loans, gifts, or purchases.

ASSIGNED CATEGORY

The 10 selected applicatants will be divided into groups of 2 for the assignment. Based on expertise, each group will be appointed a specific TEFAF category to focus on. These categories not only include painting and sculpture from all centuries, but also ancient art, furniture, design, objects, jewellery, etc.

MENTOR SESSIONS

During the course, groups will be matched with a senior vetting member. These pairings will be made according to specific categories, allowing participants to explore the fair in a focused manner.

This setup will create a platform for participants to engage with seasoned colleagues, inquire about the challenges and opportunities within the acquisition process, and foster lasting professional relationships.

LECTURE TOPICS

Throughout the course, lectures and interviews will be conducted at the university and fair focusing on various relevant topics to guide and inform the participants personal growth and development, such as art market dynamics and the art business, legal issues, provenance and fundraising.



The application process for the *TEFAF Curator Course* involves an evaluation by a selection committee comprising representatives from TEFAF and Maastricht University. The committee comprises TEFAF Board members, TEFAF Vetting members, and Maastricht University representatives. Here's a step-by-step breakdown of the application process:

REQUIREMENTS

Interested individuals should submit their applications, including the required documents: a curriculum vitae (CV), a letter of motivation, at least three years of curatorial experience, and a reference letter from a senior colleague or board member.

REVIEW BY COMMITTEE

The selection committee convenes to review the eligible applications. Each committee member assesses the applications based on the applicant's qualifications, experience, motivation, and preferred focus category.

REFERENCE CHECK

For the shortlisted candidates, the committee might contact the provided senior colleague or board member referenced to verify the applicant's qualifications and potential for the program.

October 1, 2025
